### Welcome

Here at The Forge Holiday Letting we want all of our guests/visitors to enjoy their time with us and as such be able to have as much accessibility as is possible. To assist with this ambition we have drawn-up an Access Guide to help the reader in deciding the suitability of our properties for their needs.

The Forge and Smithy are old and traditional rustic self-catering cottages located in rural Lincolnshire - both have been refurbished to the highest standards to include modern conveniences - whilst retaining all of the charm and nostalgia of the past.

### At a Glance

#### Level Access

- The main entrances of the Forge and Smithy each have 1 step. There are no lifts or ramps.
- There is level access from the main entrance to:
  - Downstairs toilet - Forge only

#### Access with steps

- There are small steps to access or leave both the Forge and Smithy

## Bedrooms

- We have non-allergic bedding.

## Level access bedrooms

- The route to the bedrooms is >750mm wide.
  - Forge bedrooms are on the first floor
  - Smithy bedroom is level access
- The bedroom doors are 750mm wide, or more.

## Hearing

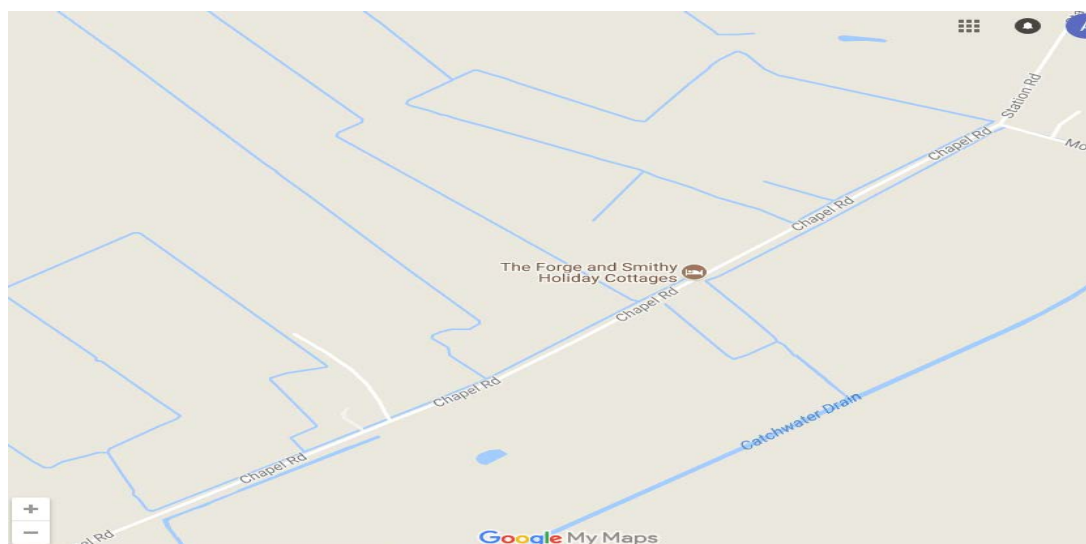
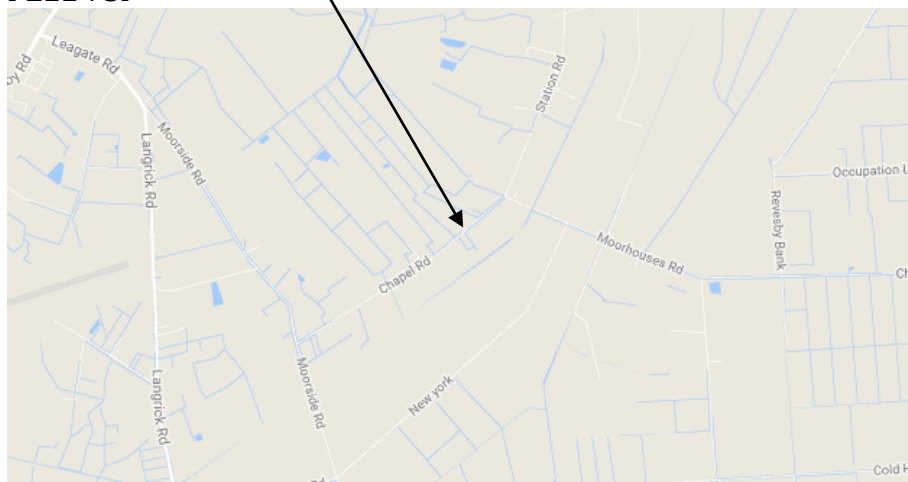
- The TVs have subtitles functionality available if selected.

## Travel by public transport

- You can get to The Forge Holiday Letting by bus and train.
- Coningsby offers the nearest large bus stop. However, Lincolnshire's Call Connect service can provide transportation to/from your door - see <http://www.lincsinterconnect.com/information/callconnect.phtml>  
The bus stop is 4.1 miles / 6.6 km from The Forge Holiday Letting.
- The nearest train station is Hubberts Bridge. The train station is 10.3 miles / 16.6 km from The Forge Holiday Letting.  
Boston also offers a larger train station which is 11.8 miles away.

## Parking

- We have a car park. There are accessible parking spaces. The parking is less than 5 metres from the main entrances over a gravel driveway. Parking is free.
- The vehicular parking is in property-specific open areas and is level to enable easy disembarking. From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The route is open.

## Arrival

### Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- It is open areas from your car parking to the main entrances.

### Main entrance

- The main doors are side hung and manual.
- The doors are 780mm wide.
- The Forge and Smithy main entrances each have one step (150mm).

- When you arrive, we can help carry your luggage.
- If assistance is required on arrival guests are advised to forewarn. This said, all guests are usually met/greeted on arrival

## Getting around inside

### Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- Bedrooms have ceiling lights and bedside lamps (some have wall lights).
- Lights are traditional filament.
- TVs have subtitle functionality.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- We have non-allergic bedding.
- No bedrooms have fitted carpets (there are rugs/mats in most rooms).
- Whilst access to the Smithy bedroom is level access, all bedrooms in the Forge are on the first floor – access is gained up a steep traditional Victorian cottage style staircase (which is not suitable for those with mobility or stability issues).

### Self-catering kitchen

#### The Forge & Smithy

- We have open-plan kitchens.
- Forge & Smithy - from the main entrance to the kitchens there is 1 step (110mm). There is no lift and no ramp.
- Forge & Smithy - after the small step (from main entrance into kitchen/dining room) thereafter level access on ground levels of each accommodation

## Lounge

### Forge

- Access to the lounge areas is level from the kitchen/dining areas. There is no lift and no ramp.

### Smithy

- Access to the conservatory/lounge area is from the main entrance.
- There is a small step (150mm) at the main entrance. There is no lift and no ramp.

### Downstairs toilet - Forge

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. The route is >780mm wide.
- The door is 780mm wide.

### Bath and Shower rooms

- The bath and shower room in the Forge is on the first floor. There is a small step to gain access into the corner shower.

### Gardens

- From the main entrances to the area, there is 1 step (150mm). There is no lift and no ramp.
- Additionally, there is a small dwarf wall pathway around the side of the Forge which has several small steps. This pathway is narrow.
- The drive and pathways all have gravel/stone-chip laid
